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HARKESH MANUJA, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions from Ms. Neha Sharan, Tehsildar-cum-Consolidation Officer, Badkhal, Faridabad, submits that the compliance of order dated 15.09.2022 (Annexure P-1) passed by the writ Court shall be made within a period of three weeks from today.

[2] In view of the aforesaid stand / undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.

[3] Dismissed as not pressed.

[4] However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring / concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.

[5] Rule stands discharged.
