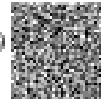

In the present petition, grievance being raised by the petitioner is that the petitioner was minor when his father died on 05.12.2002 and immediately when the petitioner gained the age of majority, he approached the respondents for the grant of benefit of compassionate appointment, which claim of the petitioner is not being decided by the respondents and that too without any valid justification.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner had filed numbers of representation with the respondents and ultimately served a legal notice dated 14.06.2024 (Annexure P/13), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage in case, a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice.

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Mr. T.P.S Chawla, Senior DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents and submits that in case, legal notice dated 14.06.2024 (Annexure P/13) has been received from the petitioner and is still pending consideration with the respondents, the same will be decided in accordance with law and appropriate order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and in case, it is found feasible, the relief will be extended to petitioner otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the order so passed, which will be conveyed to the petitioner as well for his information and necessary action.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
