HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Mr.Durgesh, Deputy Superintendent, Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Haryana, submits that the necessary orders with respect to the regularization of the services of the petitioner on the post of Computer Clerk/Operator shall be passed within a period of one week from today and necessary arrears against it shall be released to him, within a period of 05 weeks thereafter.

2. In view thereof, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the present petition.

3. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed being not pressed. Rule stands discharged.

However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the dealing official

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as well as the officer concerned would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- each (total 01 lakh) as costs from their own pockets in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
