1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioner in view of Punjab Government Policy dated 04.03.1999 (Annexure P-1) and to give all consequential benefits arising therefrom.
2. On receipt of advance copy of the writ petition, it has been pointed out by learned counsel for the respondents that from May, 2016 onwards till date, the petitioner is the employee of the private contractor as she was engaged by the contractor. However, the said fact has not been disclosed in the present petition.
3. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to file a fresh petition on the same cause of action with better particulars.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
