1. Petitioner has filed instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No.47 dated 20.03.2018 under Sections 392, 397, 307 and 427 of IPC and under Section 25 and 27 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Punjab Agriculture University (PAU), District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.
2. Learned counsel for petitioner stated that present petition has rendered infructuous as criminal case in the aforesaid FIR has been concluded and the accused has been acquitted by the trial Court on 04.07.2024. Therefore, she does not want to pursue the instant petition and withdraws the same.
