1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the impugned order dated 30.05.2019 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent authorities whereby private respondents No.3 to 5 have been promoted/assigned the work to the post of Executive Engineer (Class-A), with a further prayer to quash the impugned order dated 06.02.2020 (Annexure P-5) whereby respondent No.6 has been promoted to the post of Executive Engineer and to quash the impugned order dated 25.07.2019 (Annexure P-6) whereby respondent No.7 has been promoted to the post of SDE.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner had served a legal notice dated 01.12.2023 (Annexure P-7) to respondent No.2 but the same has not been considered and decided till date. He further submitted that at this stage, he will be satisfied in case the aforesaid illegal notice dated



01.12.2023 (Annexure P-7) is considered and decided by respondent No.2 in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Rajni Gupta, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents. She submitted that in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, she has no objection in case time bound direction is issued in this regard.
5. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, without calling for reply from the respondents and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the illegal notice dated 01.12.2023 (Annexure P-7) strictly in accordance with law and within a period of four months from today.
