Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to issue Police Clearance Certificate to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the matrimonial dispute between the petitioner and his wife has been settled and the FIR has already been quashed by this Court vide order dated 26.09.2024 passed in CRM-M-22553-2024.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the factum of quashing of the FIR and contends that since the FIR has been recently quashed, the Police Clearance Certificate could not be issued. He contends that in the event of the petitioner submitting an application afresh for issuance of Police Clearance Certificate alongwith the necessary documents/details, the needful shall be done in accordance with law expeditiously.

Counsel for the petitioner is thus satisfied with the aforesaid statement made by the learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Paramjit Singh, Police Station Sadar Jagraon.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Needless to mention that in the event of the petitioner moving an application for issuance of Police Clearance Certificate, the same shall be issued in favour of the petitioner expeditiously.
