KARAMJIT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case having FIR No. 90 dated 24.04.2024, under Sections 120-B, 406, 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Panipat City, District Panipat.

2. On the last date of hearing, this Court passed order granted interim bail to the petitioner with direction to join the investigation Today, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner apprised the Court that in light of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police.

3. The State counsel on instructions from ASI Rajesh has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by counsel for the petitioner. The State counsel further submits that specimen signatures of the petitioner are required for their comparison with the disputed signatures on the sale deed in question which was executed with regard to plot measuring 100 square

yards. It is further submitted that otherwise the petitioner is not required by the police for any further investigation or custodial interrogation.

4. In light of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 17.09.2024 is hereby made absolute. The petitioner is to abide by the conditions as are provided under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023. The petitioner is also to appear before the Court concerned for giving his specimen signatures as and when called to do so by the police or the Court concerned.
