Prayer in the instant civil writ petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 27.07.2023 (Annexure P-5), passed by respondent No. 1 (Financial Commissioner, Punjab) whereby the appeal filed by the petitioner against order dated 23.01.2023 (Annexure P-1), passed by respondent No. 2 (Director, Rural Development and Panchayat Department, Punjab) has been dismissed.
2. There is no representation on behalf of petitioner.
3. Learned State counsel submits that the instant writ petition has been rendered infructuous as all the Gram Panchayats in the State of Punjab stand dissolved, vide Notification dated 27.02.2024.
