1. Through the instant petition, filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. read with Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer is made for grant of 'interim bail' to the present petitioner, in case FIR No.147, dated 12.04.2024, under Sections 302, 323, 449, 506 and 120-B of the IPC, registered at Police Station Gannaur, Haryana, during the pendency of the trial, on the ground that the petitioner has been blessed with a child and he is to look after his wife.

2. In deference to the directions issued by this Court vide order dated 12.09.2024, while issuing notice of motion, a reply, dated 17.09.2024, by way of an affidavit of Sh.Rajpal, ACP, Crime, Sonipat, has been filed, by the learned State counsel today in Court, which is taken on record, with a copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. A perusal of the reply (*supra*), reflects that the present petitioner has been blessed with a male child. It further reveals that the petitioner has clean antecedents as he is not involved in any other criminal case, except the instant FIR, and further there is no material on record which could reflect that the petitioner may flee from the clutches of law.

4. In view of the above, the instant petition, is **allowed**, and the petitioner is granted the relief of 'interim bail' for a period of two weeks, from the date of furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial court/CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

5. The petitioner shall re-step into the prison immediately after completion of two weeks of interim bail from the date of furnishing such bail and surety bonds.

6. In case, petitioner fails to step back into the prison on completion of interim bail period, the SHO concerned, shall arrest him and thereupon, send him to the concerned jail.

7. All pending applications, if any, also stand **disposed** of accordingly.
