Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail under
Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.0138 dated 21.05.2023 registered under
Sections 306, 34 of the IPC registered at Police Station BPTP, District
Faridabad.

On 07.11.2023, following order was passed:

*For the reasons recorded in the application, the same is
allowed. Accompanying affidavit is taken on record subject to all just
exceptions.*

Main case

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in the present case the petitioner alongwith two more boys were living in a common room with the deceased and there are allegations of harassment and blackmailing with regard to selling of mobile phone. He submitted that there is no ingredient of abetment to commit suicide in the present case even as per the suicide note (Annexure P-3).

Notice of motion.

Mr. Naveen Kumar Sheoran, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State of Haryana.

Mr. Ashok Kaushik, Advocate has appeared on behalf of the complainant and has prayed for some time to file affidavit.

Adjourned to 19.02.2024.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to join investigation and to co-operate fully with the investigation process and on his doing so, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting /Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Today learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ram Singh, submits that petitioner has since joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

Having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case order dated 07.11.2023 is hereby made absolute, whereby petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation

as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
