The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to release full salary/emoluments and allowances to the petitioner along with interest on delayed payment of arrears of pay and allowances. Further a writ of certiorari has been sought for quashing the advertisement dated 30.10.2019 to the extent that Assistant Lineman is entitled to monthly wages equivalent to minimum rates of wages applicable to the category of semi-skilled workers during probation period.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the impugned order dated 15.05.2023 (Annexure P-4), shall be withdrawn and in view of order passed in CM No.3538-CWP of 2024 filed in CWP No.13159 of 2020, the necessary benefits as granted vide Annexure P-3 shall be released to the petitioner.
