This petition under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed for issuance of direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondent No.4 and his goons/agents and to restrain respondent No. 4 and his goons/agents from harassing or interfering in the peaceful life of the petitioners.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners *inter alia* submits that on 03.08.2024, the petitioners were attacked by respondent No. 4 alongwith 4-5 goons who were carrying deadly weapons. He further submits that the petitioners have submitted representations dated 09.08.2024 (Annexure P-3) and 09.09.2024 (Annexure P-4) before the Head DC Office, Patiala and Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala raising their grievances as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. He further



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submitted that at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereon.

3. Notice of motion.
4. At the asking of the Court, Mr. Vinay Kumar, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent(s)-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.
5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the aforesaid representation dated 09.09.2024 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioners expeditiously, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
6. Needless to say, if any threat is found to the petitioner, the official respondents would provide him adequate security in order to protect his life and liberty.
