1. The present revision petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 seeking direction to the learned trial Court to conclude the trial in criminal case having FIR No. 84 dated 16.07.2021 under Sections 307, 394, 467, 511, 323, 482, 411, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Navi Baradari, Jalandhar, in a time bound manner.
2. The counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is an accused in aforesaid criminal case wherein charges were framed on 03.03.2022 and till date, prosecution is unable to examine any witness and it will take time for trial to conclude.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. J.S. Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State and apprised the Court that trial is going on and already two witnesses are examined out of total 15 witnesses on behalf of the prosecution. The State counsel has not disputed the fact that trial Court



framed charges in this very case on 03.03.2022.

5. Taking into consideration, the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of and the learned trial Court is requested to make sincere efforts to conclude the prosecution evidence by giving short dates and to decide the trial preferably within a period of next 1 ½ year.
