

3. It has been submitted that the marriage of the petitioners was solemnized on 09.09.2024. The marriage certificate and photographs are attached as Annexure P-3 and P-4. Private respondents Nos.4 to 8 had opposed to their marriage, as the petitioners had performed the marriage without their consent. The petitioners have submitted representation dated 09.09.2024 (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Palwal seeking protection of their lives and liberty at the hands of the private respondents.
4. Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 3.
5. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Karan Sharma, DAG, Haryana. accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3.
6. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter and in particular the legality of the alleged relationship, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to Superintendent of Police, Palwal to forthwith consider the aforesaid representation dated 09.09.2024 made on behalf of the petitioners and thereafter, take appropriate action on the same as is deemed fit in accordance with law to ensure the protection of life and liberty of the petitioners. Till then, protect the life and liberty of the petitioners. Respondent No.2 would pass necessary order within a period of one month without being influenced by any pleadings made in the petition.
7. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to validate the alleged relationship between the petitioners or protect them from legal action for violation, if any, committed by them.
