FAO-6272-2013

1. The present appeal has been preferred against the judgment and

decree dated 23.09.2013, passed by the learned District Judge, Family Court, Gurgaon, whereby the petition filed by appellant (husband) for dissolution of marriage by a decree of divorce under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, has been dismissed.

2. In the course of arguments, a decree dated 06.01.2024, passed under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, by learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Palampur, District Kangra, H.P., has been produced in Court today itself, which is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

3. On behalf of appellant, it has been submitted that since the matter has already been compromised and settled between the parties, therefore, appellant does not want to pursue the instant appeal and hence seeks permission to withdraw the same.

4. Permission accorded.

5. With the aforesaid observations, the instant appeal is dismissed as withdrawn.
