1. Through the instant petition, prayer is made for issuing a *mandamus* upon the official respondent no.2, to decided decide her representation dated 08.07.2024 (Annexure P-1).

2. A perusal of the instant petition reflects that, in fact the instant petition is a misconceived motion, inasmuch as, despite the petitioner being seized of an alternate and efficacious statutory remedy for redressal of her grievance, yet she has sidetracked the said remedy and have straightway accessed this Court, through instituting the present petition.

3. Faced with the above difficulty, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the instant petition, however, with liberty reserved to the petitioner to recourse with an alternative available statutory remedy(ies) before the appropriate authority/forum concerned, for redressal of his grievance.
