1. The petitioner having been declared as a proclaimed person by the learned trial Court concerned vide order dated 20.5.2024 passed in a private complaint No.CNR No.PBBT030055642021, CIS No.NACT-1062-2023, titled “Pushapdeep Singh Vs. Master Sukhpal Singh etc.”, has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, for grant of pre-arrest bail.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner at the very outset submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to surrender before the learned trial Court concerned and to face the trial. However, he made a prayer that a



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mandamus be passed upon the learned trial Court concerned to decide his bail application on the same day.

3. The innocuous and bonafide prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner is accepted and the instant petition is **disposed** of with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court concerned within 10 days from today. Further, in case the petitioner surrenders before the learned trial Court concerned within 10 days from today and file his regular bail application before the Court concerned, the latter shall decide the same on that day itself.
