1. By way of present petition filed under Section 215 of the Constitution of India read with Sections 11 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, prayer has been made for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for willful non-compliance of the order dated 18.04.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-32393-2019.
2. Compliance report by way of an affidavit of Er. Rajesh Kumar, Senior Executive Engineer, City West Division, Punjab State Power Corporation Limited, Ludhiana (Punjab), has been filed in Court, which is taken on record.
3. Learned State counsel representing the respondents submits that the order qua which the contempt proceedings have been sought, stands complied with, thereby rendering the present petition as infructuous.
4. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.
5. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.



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6.            However, in case the petitioner still has any grievance, he may move representation before the respondents within a period of two weeks from today and the same shall be considered and decided within four weeks thereafter from the date of its receipt by way of passing a speaking order, which shall be communicated to the petitioner within a period of two weeks thereafter.
