1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.45 dated 02.08.2024, under Section 406 IPC registered at Police Station Tarsikka, District Amritsar.
2. Vide order dated 13.09.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, however, the same remained unsuccessful. He submits that pursuant to order dated 13.09.2024, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.
4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant has opposed the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

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5. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Palwinder Singh, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

6. In view of the above, interim order dated 13.09.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.

7. Petition stands allowed.
