The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the order dated 21.01.2022 (Annexure P-8), whereby arrears of 100% family pension of the petitioner though has been fixed, however, the same have been restricted to 36 months.

2. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the impugned order dated 21.01.2022 has been reviewed and the necessary payment on account of arrears of family pension along with interest amounting to Rs.2,13,490/- has been credited to the account of the petitioner.

3. In this view of the matter, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of accordingly.
