This petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant the petitioner the benefit of notional pay fixation and seniority by fixing her pay at par with the candidates given joining in the first list.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case the second respondent is directed to decide the pending representation, dated 04.08.2024, Annexure P-4, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Tanushree Gupta, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice and submits that the pending representation shall be decided by the second respondent expeditiously.

5. In view thereof, without going into merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the second respondent-Director, Secondary Education, to consider and decide the pending representation, dated 04.08.2024, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.

6. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹25,000 to the petitioner.
