1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking setting aside of order dated 11.07.2023 (Annexure P-1) passed by Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur-respondent No.4 whereby they have been suspended.
2. The petitioners, on account of registration of FIR No.136 dated 26.06.2023 under Sections 454 & 380 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station City Gurdaspur, have been suspended and directed to report to the office of Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural).
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that on account of media pressure aforesaid FIR has been registered against the petitioners. The FIR was registered in June' 2023 and till date investigation has not been completed. The suspension is causing irreparable loss to the petitioners.
4. Mr. Inderpreet Singh Kang, AAG, Punjab, who on advance notice is present in Court on behalf of the respondents, submits that

Investigating Officer would complete its investigation within six weeks from today and thereafter, representation of the petitioner would be considered and decided in accordance with law.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees with the aforesaid arrangement.

6. In the wake of statements of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of.
