GURBIR SINGH, J. (ORAL)

1. The prayer in the present criminal writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to official respondents No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner endangered at the hands of respondent Nos.4 and 5, who in connivance with each other are harassing the petitioner despite representation moved against them as well as registration of police case against them, no action has been taken by the official respondents so far.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits a representation dated 29.06.2024 (Annexure P-1) was given to official respondent No.2, Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar but no action has been taken against respondents Nos.4 and 5.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Manjot Kaur, AAG, Punjab has appeared in this case in pursuance of the notice of the instant petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance.

5. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the representation made by him to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar is directed to be decided expeditiously.
6. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar is directed to decide the representation of petitioner expeditiously and not later than two months from today.
