1. Petitioner has filed instant petition under Section 528 of BNSS for quashing of FIR No.95 dated 27.09.2023 under Sections 323, 294, 341, 506 of IPC registered at Police Station Division No.5, District Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar (Annexure P-1) on the basis of compromise dated 02.09.2024 (Annexure P-2)

2. Learned counsel representing State pointed out that this is second petition seeking quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise and copy of order annexed with the present petition is Annexure P-4. Perusal of order dated 28.05.2024 indicates that said petition was dismissed for want of prosecution.

3. At this stage, learned counsel for petitioner states that he does not want to pursue the present petition and withdraw the same with liberty to restore the previous petition bearing CRM-M-16330-2024 which was dismissed for want of prosecution vide order dated 28.05.2024 (Annexure
