MANISHA BATRA, J (ORAL):-

Through the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.107 dated 05.11.2022 registered under Sections 346 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short ‘IPC’) (later on added Sections 363, 365, 366, 370, 511 and 376-D of IPC) at Police Station City Morinda, District Rupnagar.

2. Vide order dated 25.09.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

4. In view of the said facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 25.09.2023 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
