The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.367 dated 02.11.2020, under Section 132 of Central Goods And Services Tax Act, (CGST),2017 Sections 406,419,420,465,467,471 of IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Sirsa (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 13.09.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
3. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
4. In view of the above statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 13.09.2024 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue

to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 (2) of Cr.P.C.
