1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 read with Section 2(b) of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for violating the order dated 29.09.2022 passed in CWP-22751-2022.
2. Mr. Tarang Goyal, Advocate, puts in appearance on behalf of respondent Nos.3 to 6 and Mr. Umang Goyal, Advocate, puts in appearance on behalf of respondent Nos.7 & 8 and filed power of attorney, which are taken on record.
3. Learned counsel for official respondents has submitted that the complaint raised by the petitioner has duly been considered by the authority and due action has been taken against the person indulging in illegal mining and an FIR No.113 dated 23.11.2023, under Section 21(1) read with Section 4(1) of Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulations), Act, 1957 at Police Station Sri Chamkaur Sahib has also been registered.
4. In view of the above, this petition does not survive any more.
5. Dismissed.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
