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**AMARJOT BHATTI, J.**

1. Petitioner Amit has filed petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.335 dated 12.08.2024, under Section 22(c) of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Narnaund, District Hissar, Haryana.

2. On filing of present anticipatory bail petition, arrest of petitioner was stayed vide order dated 16.09.2024.

3. Learned counsel representing State has already filed status report through Registry, which is taken on record. It is confirmed that present petitioner was named in disclosure statement of main accused Satyanarain with the allegation that he had purchased intoxicant tablets for a sum of Rs.10,000/- from petitioner. Therefore, said amount is to be recovered and

the persons involved in drug trafficking are to be disclosed.



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4. I have considered the aforesaid arguments and have gone through the record. It is not disputed that present petitioner has joined investigation. He is involved in this case on the basis of disclosure statement. There is nothing on record to show that after disclosure of name of present petitioner, any action was taken by the investigating officer to effect further recovery. Now present petitioner has joined the investigation and still ready to do so. Therefore, no purpose would be served by sending the petitioner behind the bars. Accordingly, anticipatory bail petition filed by petitioner –Amit is allowed. He be not arrested. In case of his arrest, he be released on bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer concerned, subject to condition that petitioner will join investigation as and when required. He will not tamper with or interfere with investigation and will not leave country without prior permission as provided under Section 482(2) BNSS.

5. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
