HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. In the present writ petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioners is that they are not being given the salary equivalent to their counterparts who are working in the Punjabi University and even further, their mobile allowance has been reduced from Rs.1000/- to Rs.600/- and that too without giving any opportunity of hearing.

2. Learned senior counsel for the petitioners submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioner in the representation dated 30.11.2022 (Annexure P-11) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Gaurav Kalsi, Advocate, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-University.

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5. Learned counsel for the respondent-University submits that in case the representation dated 30.11.2022 (Annexure P-11) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, after the decision any relief is to be extended to the petitioners, the same will be extended, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioners for their information and necessary action.

6. At this stage, learned senior counsel for the petitioners submits that liberty be given to the petitioners to supplement the representation already filed, which additional representation will be filed within a period of one week from today and the same be also taken into account while deciding the claim of the petitioners.

7. Learned counsel for the respondent-University submits that any supplementary representation filed within one week will also be taken into account while deciding the claim of the petitioners.

8. Learned senior counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

9. Ordered accordingly.
