1. Prayer in this writ petition is for setting aside demand notice dated 29.06.2022 issued under Section 13(2) of Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 (hereinafter referred to as the SARFAESI Act) and possession notice dated 17.10.2022, under Section 13(4) of the SARFAESI Act.
2. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that though writ petition itself is not entertainable, he has instructions to state that notice dated 29.06.2022 under Section 13(2) of SARFAESI Act is in the process of being withdrawn within next one week, therefore this writ petition in any case is rendered infructuous.
3. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the respondent, this writ petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty to

the petitioner to avail statutory remedy(ies) as available to him, in case of any fresh proceedings which may be initiated against him by respondent-bank.

4. Pending application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
