1. Present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to the officials respondents No. 2 and 3 for taking action on the representation dated 27.10.2022 (Annexure P-1) for protecting the life and liberty of the petitioner.
2. Learned State counsel, at the very outset submits that nothing survives in the present petition and refers to para No. 6 the status report dated 27.03.2023 filed by way of affidavit of Bhupinder Singh Sidhu, PPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur on behalf of respondent No. 2 in compliance of order dated 06.12.2022 passed by this Court. Relevant paragraph is reproduced hereinbelow:

“That from the enquiry conducted uptil now, no threat perception has been found to the petitioner at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 6, so far. However, whenever there will be any threat to the life and liberty of petitioner in a real sense and she appear before the enquiry officer and record her statement in this regard, after carrying out ground level assessment, necessary action shall be immediately taken to ensure her safety and if the need be, adequate security will be provided to her, to comply with the order dated 06.12.2022 passed by this Hon’ble Court in letter and spirit.”

3. In view of the categoric stand taken by the State of Punjab as mentioned in the status report with regard to the threat perception of the petitioner, no further directions are required to be issued in the present petition and the same is hereby disposed of accordingly.
