1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant regular bail to him in case FIR No. 96 dated 19.07.2023, registered under Sections 307, 323, 324, 148, 149 of IPC, Police Station City-1, Mansa District Mansa (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that as per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner had caused an injury with a gandasa on the left arm of the complainant and the said injury has been declared to be simple in nature. He further contends that the petitioner was arrested in the present case on 16.04.2024 and the challan against him has already been presented before the competent Court. He further contends that the co-accused, namely Jashandeep Singh @ Jassu, Gurjinder Singh, Satwinder Sngh @ Sammi, Jashan Singh alias Jassi alias Jashandeep Singh, Manyog Singh, Manpreet Singh @ Joka @ Tiwana, Rajdeep Singh and Sukhveer Singh alias Arshdeep alias Shani Maan have already been granted the concession of bail by this Court vide



Annexures P-2 to P-9, respectively. He further contends that the injured in the present case have already been discharged.

3. On the other hand, learned State counsel has vehemently opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner on the ground that serious allegations have been levelled against the present petitioner and he does not deserve the concession of bail by this Court.

4. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the record carefully.

5. The petitioner is in custody for the last five months and the challan has already been presented by the police. Even the injury, which is attributed to the petitioner, is simple in nature. Apart from that, other co-accused, namely, namely, Jashandeep Singh @ Jassu, Gurjinder Singh, Satwinder Sngh @ Sammi, Jashan Singh alias Jassi alias Jashandeep Singh, Manyog Singh, Manpreet Singh @ Jokas @ Tiwana, Rajdeep Singh and Sukhveer Singh alias Arshdeep alias Shani Maan have already been granted the concession of bail by this Court vide orders Annexures P-2 to P-9, respectively. Thus, no purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner behind bars.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail pending trial on his furnishing bail bonds and surety to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/ Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate.
