1. The petitioners have filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioners. Further directing the respondents not to dispense with the services of the petitioners or replace them by outsourced workers during the pendency of the present petition.

2. On receipt of advance copy of the writ petition, it has been pointed out by learned counsel for the respondents that from May, 2016 onwards till date, the petitioners are the employees of the private contractor as they were engaged by the contractor. However, the said fact has not been disclosed in the present petition.

3. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to file a fresh petition on the same cause of action with better particulars.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
