1. The instant petition has been filed for seeking compensation on account of mental harassment and agony purportedly on account of the DJ being played at odd hours and beyond the permissible limits.
2. The petitioner, who is present in person, informs that she had moved an application before the Illaqa Magistrate and the same is still pending. Be that as it may, since the petitioner has taken recourse to the appropriate proceedings in accordance with law which are still pending, the present petition is disposed of as not pressed at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to take recourse to alternative remedies available to her in accordance with law.
3. Needless to mention that the Illaqa Magistrate shall expedite the process of adjudication of the application preferred by the petitioner, if any, pending before it.
4. The present petition is accordingly disposed of as not pressed with the liberty as aforesaid.
