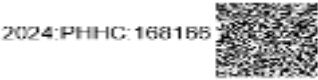

1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.272 dated 13.08.2024, under Sections 15(b), 27-A, 61, 85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Bhuna, District Fatehabad.
2. Status report by way of affidavit of Mr. Jagdish Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Bhuna has been filed on behalf of respondent-State, in the Court today, same is taken on record.
3. Vide order dated 17.09.2024 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 17.09.2024, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.
5. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Krishan, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.



6. In view of the above, interim order dated 17.09.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.

7. Petition stands allowed.
