Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitione~~r~~ gave one complaint in writing to the police authorities against respondent No.4 and the matter was enquired into by Deputy Superintendent of Police who made recommendation for taking legal action against the culprits but till date no FIR has been registered against the culprits and nothing has been conveyed to the petitioner. It is further submitted that during aforesaid inquiry, the statement (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner was recorded. Being aggrieved, the petitioner has filed the present petition.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. J.S. Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that in case any such complaint/representation given by the petitioner is still pending, the competent authority will look into the matter and decide the same at the earliest.

4. In light of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of with direction



to respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation/complaint already submitted by the petitioner wherein the matter was enquired by DSP, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order in accordance with law by passing a speaking order and the copy of the same is to be supplied to the petitioner within 7 days of passing of the said order.
