HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)

1. By way of present petition, prayer has been made for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents on account of alleged willful non-compliance of order dated 23.05.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-178-2019.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions, submits that the case of the petitioners has been considered and all the dues payable to the petitioners shall be released in their favour within a period of two weeks from today.

3. In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition, as such, the same is disposed of. Rule stands discharged.

4. However, in case the needful is not done within the
aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioners would be at
liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the
erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs
from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioners towards litigation
expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
