Counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* submits that the mother of petitioner and respondent No.4 was in Government service and she died in harness. Now there is a dispute between the parties with regard to service benefits of their mother. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that respondent No.4 used certain fake documents to get job on compassionate grounds on account of death of her mother. In this regard, petitioner has already given representation dated 07.08.2024 (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, but the police authorities failed to take any action. Being aggrieved, the petitioner has filed the present petition.

2. Notice of motion.



3. Mr. Jasjeet Singh Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and on instructions from ASI Jaspal Singh submits that the petitioner appeared before the police authorities and got recorded her statement to the effect that she is going to withdraw the aforesaid representation.
4. At this stage, counsel for the petitioner submits that he is having clear instructions that the petitioner was compelled to record her statement under pressure and threat from the opposite side.
5. In light of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to consider and decide representation dated 07.08.2024 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioner, in accordance with law within a period of Six weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
