Prayer in this writ petition is for quashing notice dated 15.03.2022 (Annexure P-4) issued under Section 13 (2) of Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 (for short 'SARFAESI Act'), notice dated 30.06.2022 (Annexure P-5) issued under Section 13 (4) and order dated 17.08.2022 (Annexure P-6) passed by District Magistrate, Kaithal under Section 14 of SARFAESI Act.
