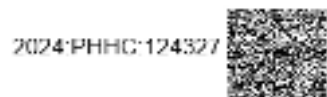

The present criminal writ petition has been filed under article 226 of the constitution of India read with section 482 of the code of criminal procedure, 1973, seeking police protection and directions to respondents no. 2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that she will be satisfied in case a direction be issued to respondent No.3 to look into the complaints dated 23.08.2024 and 25.08.2024 (Annexure P-4), within a time bound manner

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of without advertng to the merits of the case, with a direction to respondent No.3/Deputy Commissioner of Police (DCP), Gurgaon, Haryana, to look into the complaints dated 23.08.2024 and 25.08.2024 (Annexure P-4) and decide the same by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of two weeks with a copy of order so passed supplied to the petitioner, within three days thereafter.
