By way of present petition filed under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under: -

2. After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner will surrender before the Court and move an application for bail and accordingly, seeks withdrawal of the present petition at this stage. However, he submits that the learned trial Court may be asked to dispose of the application for bail in expeditious manner.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.
4. However, it is ordered that in case, the petitioner surrenders within seven days from today and move an application for bail, the same may be dealt with in accordance with law in expeditious manner.
