Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to official respondent no. 2 and 3 for taking immediate appropriate action in complaint dated 18.12.2023 filed before respondent No. 1 by the petitioner (Annexure P-1) along with other complaints made on different dates to different authorities qua the same grievance and to act according to law in the light of directions issued by Hon'ble Apex Court in Lalita Kumari Vs Govt. of U. P., 2013(4) RCR (Criminal) 979, thereby taking appropriate legal action against respondents so as to ensure fair and free investigation into the allegations of the petitioners made through complaints to the official respondents for lodging of FIR.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is presently living in Germany and has filed the present petition through attorney. He submits that the petitioner is being harassed by his wife and her family members by way of filing false and frivolous complaints against him time and again.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner it is apparent that the petitioner before this Court is husband of complainant, who is presently

living in Germany. The dispute between the husband and wife is totally of matrimonial nature and the petitioner has alternative remedy available to him. In view of this, no interference is called for by this Court. The present petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to avail his alternative remedy as available to him under law.
