1. While issuing notice of motion on 18.10.2023, following order was passed:-

“Grievance of the petitioner is against order dated 10th of October, 2022 (Annexure P-4) whereby the bail bonds of the petitioner have been ordered to be cancelled and the surety stands forfeited.

FIR is dated 30th of November, 2018. Challan was presented on 19th of April, 2021. It has been contended that the petitioner was under treatment before Rehabilitation Centre since 10th of May, 2019. Reliance is being placed upon Annexure P-3 to substantiate the aforesaid plea.

Issue notice of motion returnable for 01.02.2024.

Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

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The petitioner is granted liberty to appear before the Trial Court on the next date of hearing fixed before it i.e. 11th of December, 2023.

In the meantime, operation of the impugned order (Annexure P-4) shall remain in abeyance.”

2. Today, counsel for the petitioner has produced order dated 11.12.2023 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar to demonstrate that the petitioner appeared before the trial Court in compliance of the order dated 18.10.2023 passed by this Court and submits that the petitioner undertakes to appear regularly. Hence, no further order is required to be passed.
3. In view of above, the interim order dated 18.10.2023 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to the conditions as enumerated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
4. Petition stands disposed off.
