1. By way of the present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India prayer is for issuance direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No.4 to 13.

2. At the very outset, learned State counsel has filed status report in Court today and the same is taken on record. The relevant part of the status report be read as under:-

“5. That after receiving the notice of the present petition, an enquiry has been conducted by the local police and during the course of enquiry, the petitioners were also joined in the enquiry and they have categorically stated that they are residing peacefully and they are not apprehending danger from the private respondents. The statements of the petitioners are annexed as Annexure R-2 to R-8. The private respondents were also joined in the enquiry proceedings and they have categorically stated that they have not caused any danger to the petitioners. The private respondents have also further stated that they will not cause any danger to the petitioners in future.

The statements of the private respondents are annexed as Annexure R-9 to R-18.

6. That the petitioners were also joined in the enquiry proceedings and they have specifically contended that they are residing at their houses peacefully and happily. They are not apprehending danger from the private respondents. The local police has also conducted an enquiry into the present case after receiving the notice of the present petition and the enquiry report is annexed as Annexure R-19.”

3. In view of above, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is disposed of as infructuous.
