KULDEEP TIWARI, J. (ORAL)

1. Through the instant petition, as instituted under Section 482 of the B.N.S.S., the petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail, in case FIR No.123 dated 14.11.2023, under Sections 323, 324 of the IPC (offence under Section 307, 148, 149 of the IPC added subsequently), registered at P.S. Division No.5, District Police Commissionerate Jalandhar.
2. After addressing arguments for some time, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the instant petition, however, with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court concerned and to make an application for bail before the latter, which may be directed to be decided expeditiously.
3. Leave granted.
4. Consequently, the instant petition is **dismissed as withdrawn**, however, with liberty to the petitioner to, within 10 days from today, surrender before the learned trial Court concerned, and

thereupon, if he makes an application before the latter for grant of bail, the latter shall decide the same within two days, but, after affording adequate opportunity of hearing to the opposite party.
