By way of present petition filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under: -

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 23.10.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

3. During the course of hearing on 23.10.2024, following order had been passed: -

“ Arguments heard.

Considering the arguments in the light of the documents on record, it transpires that the petitioner is



alleged to be sitting in the car along with coaccused Jobanjit Singh and Gurjinder Singh. The co-accused Jobanjit Singh had fired from the pistol on the car of the complainant thereby injuring the brother of the complainant. As per learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner is not having any criminal antecedent nor any specific overt act is attributed to him in causing injury to the injured and is ready to join investigation.

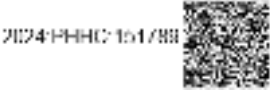
Learned State counsel while referring to the status report has not disputed this fact that no injury is attributed to the petitioner and the petitioner is having clear antecedents.

In the meanwhile, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petitioner is hereby directed to join investigation within seven days from today and co-operate in the same. In the event of the arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.”

4. Learned State counsel on instructions received from S.I. Arjan Singh informs the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation



consequent to the order dated 23.10.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 23.10.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

- 6. The petition stands allowed.
- 7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
