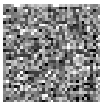

1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to pay the arrears of pension of 6th Pay Commission to the petitioner with effect from 01.01.2006 to 31.03.2010, alongwith interest at 18% per annum with all consequential benefits.
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the petitioner had served a legal notice dated 14.08.2024 (Annexure P-5) to respondents No.2 and 3 but the same has not been considered and decided till date. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case the aforesaid legal notice dated 14.08.2024 (Annexure P-5) is considered and decided by respondents No.2 and 3 in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.



3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Rajni Gupta, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents No.1 and 2 and also on behalf of respondent No.3. She submitted that in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, she has no objection in case a time bound direction is issued in this regard.
5. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, without calling for the reply from the respondents and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Kurukshetra/competent authority to consider and decide the legal notice dated 14.08.2024 (Annexure P-5) strictly in accordance with law and within a period of three months from today.
