Counsel for the petitioners submits that respondent No.4 is son of petitioner No.1 and brother of petitioner No.2. It is further submitted that respondent No.4 is unnecessarily harassing the petitioners and extending threats to cause harm to them, despite the fact that he is already given his share out of the ancestral property. That in this regard, petitioners have already given their representation dated 11.09.2024 (Annexure P-1) to the police authorities. The petitioners also approached the District Magistrate vide representation dated 15.08.2024 (Annexure P-2) and they have also filed one civil suit. It is further submitted that the District Authorities failed to take any action on the basis of Annexure P-1 and Annexure P-2. Being aggrieved, the petitioners have filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondent No.4.



2. Counsel for the petitioners further submits that petitioners will be satisfied if necessary direction in this regard is given to the concerned authorities.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Jasjeet Singh Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and submits that in case, any such representation submitted by the petitioners is pending, the same will be looked into and decided by the competent authority in accordance with law, at the earliest.
5. In light of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala to consider and decide representation dated 11.09.2024 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioners, in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
