The present review application has been filed for recalling the order dated 28.01.2013 by which the appeal was decided.

On being asked to point out the factual error in the judgment, learned counsel for the review-applicant has not been able to point out the same. Rather, the endeavour of the learned counsel for the review applicant is to re-argue the appeal so as to reach the conclusion that the judgment given by the Coordinate Bench on 28.01.2013 is incorrect.

It is a settled principle of law that under the garb of review application, appeal cannot be reargued so as to re-appreciate the facts again in order to arrive at a different conclusion than the decision already arrived at.

Keeping in view the above, no ground is made out for the review of the judgment in question. However, the applicant will have the liberty to file an appropriate remedy of appeal in case same is permissible even as of now.

Review application stands dismissed.
